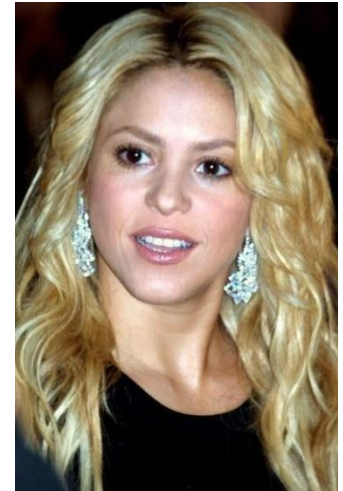


History

Topic 1: America 1920-73: Opportunity and Inequality

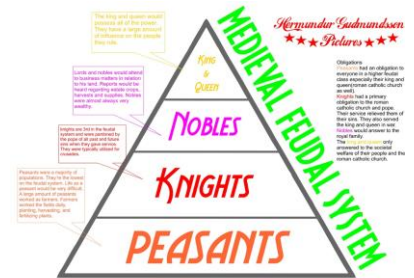


Topic 2: Conflict and Tension between East and West 1945-72
